Successful Demonstration at Cerulean Fine Arts, Hallowell Maine

(Hallowell, ME) Cerulean Fine Arts Gallery provided a demonstration on the use of ComposiMold Mold Making Materials on July 25, 2009. Nine participants worked and listened to Stan Farrell and Jason Norton discuss the use of ComposiMold and ComposiMold Starter Kit.

Mold making and casting allows you to make duplicates of your sculptures, designs, and products using a variety of materials. This demonstration shows beginner mold makers how to make simple parts using a unique reusable mold making material, ComposiMold. In this class the students learned how to prepare their own molds and make their own simple castings. Casts were made using Plaster and Polyurethane to demonstrate the mold making process. People left with knowledge about how to make a simple mold, prepare brush-on molds, cast a plaster part, and cast a polyurethane plastic part.

Examples of applications that have used ComposiMold include molds for making jewelry, model railroads, body parts for action figures, and art sculptures. The reusability of the ComposiMold has provided a low cost method for art teachers to teach mold making in classrooms.
